#### **Overall objectives**

Improve the institutional and research ICT infrastructure and human capacity to develop a robust environment for using technologies in research and teaching at UEM by 2022.

Strengthen frameworks for sustainable change through research training, institutional development and cooperation mechanisms.

#### Three outcomes

- 1.A critical mass of researchers & educators improve the quality & productivity of their work through integrated use of educational technologies & ICT tools.
- 2.Project investments in planning, modernizing & expanding ICT infrastructure, equipment & management contribute towards plan implementation and to UEM research & education goals & need for reliable and adequate ICT access.




